To relate to each other is communication!

Communication

Communication begins when we look each other in the eye.

Talk to me and listen to me! To relate to each other is communication!

What you can do:

- Look at your child – respond his or her eye contact.
- Chat and talk with your child.
- Rock your child and sing with him or her.
- Talk to your child in your native language. If your child has a good command of the first language, it's easier for him or her to learn a second one.
- Make simple sentences.
- Talk about shared experiences.
- Look at picture books and photos with your child.
- Children love to hear nursery rhymes and action rhymes (e.g. fingerplay or knee-bobbing rhymes).
- Pacifier and baby bottles in the mouth prevent clear pronunciation.
- Tell your child what you are doing.
- Listen to your child and enjoy his or her stories.

Incidentally:

Media consumption prevents communication and hinders language acquisition.
